






THROUGHOUT KINGDOM SAFARI, WE ARE PRAYING AND TRUSTING GOD FOR MULTIPLE VICTORIES:

The Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37)


DAY 1 MEMORY VERSE:

"Love your neighbor as yourself." - Galatians 5:14b

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Paper of any sort (cardstock, construction paper, etc.)
- Crayons and/or markers
- Stickers and embellishments (optional)

- Connect with a local hospital or organization to make arrangements to donate cards.
- Share with children why they are creating cards and where they will be donated.
- Provide prompts, ideas, and even Bible verses to spark children's creativity.
- Allow children to use their creativity to create cards to brighten up others!
- Collect cards when finished and deliver to your local hospital or organization of choice.



DAY 2 FORGOTTEN VOICES BANKS

DAY 2 BIG IDEA:

Love Encourages Others


DAY 2 BIBLE STORY:

The Amalekites are defeated with Moses' hands held up (Exodus 17:8-16)

DAY 2 MEMORY VERSE:

"Therefore encourage one another and build each other up."

- 1 Thessalonians 5:11a



SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- One empty soup can or water bottle per child
- Provided template printed & cut out to wrap around cans (see page 5)
- Fabric cut in squares to cover opening of can with slit cut in center of each
- Rubber bands
- Tape, washi tape, or Glue Dots®
- Ribbon (optional)

- Print can/bottle wrap template onto paper or cardstock.
- Instruct children to color and decorate their template.
- When finished decorating, wrap template around the can and secure with tape or glue dots.
- Stretch fabric square over the opening of the can and secure with a rubber band.
- Optional: Tie ribbon over the rubber band for added decoration.
- Encourage children to use their banks over the course of the rest of the week to collect a donation to support the work of Forgotten Voices.




























DAY 3 DECORATE SCHOOL BAGS



DAY 3 BIG IDEA:

Love Lends a Hand to Others

DAY 3 BIBLE STORY:

Friends of the paralyzed man (Mark 2:1-12)


DAY 3 MEMORY VERSE:

"A friend loves at all times." - Proverbs 17:17a

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Canvas Bags (can be purchased from websites like Oriental Trading®) **OR** brown kraft paper bags
- Markers

- Connect with a local school or organization to make arrangements to donate school bags filled with supplies.
- Share with children why they are creating school bags and where they will be donated.
- Provide prompts, ideas, and even Bible verses to spark children's creativity.
- Allow children to use their creativity to create bags to brighten up others!
- If you have enough supplies already collected, you could create an assembly line to have children fill their bags with supplies. We can lend a hand both near AND far!



DAY 4 FRIENDSHIP PRAYER BRACELETS



DAY 4 BIG IDEA:

Love Prays for Others

DAY 4 BIBLE STORY:

Elijah on Mount Carmel with the altar (1 Kings 18:16-39)

DAY 4 MEMORY VERSE:

"The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective."

- James 5:16b


SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Cardstock or paper cut into strips
- Pens or pencils and crayons or markers
- List of names to pray for from Forgotten Voices (see page 8)
- Tape, Glue Dots[®], or stapler to fasten bracelets
- Stickers and embellishments
- Straws and ribbon (variation)

- Distribute a strip to each child.
- Instruct children to choose names off the list to write on their strip of paper.
- Guide children to also choose the name(s) of a family member or friend they'd like to pray for to write on their bracelet.
- Allow children to decorate and embellish their bracelet.
- Fasten with tape, a Glue Dot®, or stapler to fit around child's wrist
- *As a variation to this project, cut up plastic straws and write a name on each piece. Lace the straws with string or ribbon to fit around each child's wrist.
- Encourage children to pray often for the names they see on their bracelet because prayer is POWERFUL and EFFECTIVE!

DAY 5 CHEERIOS CROSS BIRD FEEDER



SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Pipe cleaners
- Cheerios

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Distribute 2 pipe cleaners to each child.
- Instruct children to string cheerios onto both pipe cleaners, leaving space on all ends.
- With one pipe cleaner, create a loop on the end by twisting the pipe cleaner to itself. Bring the other end up and twist into a circle. (See step 1 above)
- With the other pipe cleaner, twist the ends together into a circle and pinch together so that the ends are in the center. (See step 2 above)

STEP

- Insert this pipe cleaner through the center of the first with the loop. Use the ends of the pipe cleaner in the center to wrap around the first pipe cleaner with the loop and pinch the two pipe cleaners together. (See step 3 above)
- Children now have a cross bird feeder to bring food and life to the birds just like Jesus' sacrifice on the cross brings us new life!
